Background:

Fertility C.A.R.E. is one of the most comprehensive infertility practices in the nation. Its state-of-the-art facility offers all on-site services including female and male Reproductive specialists, a CAP certified In-vitro Fertilization (IVF) laboratory with same-day procedures, a state reference laboratory for sperm testing and hormonal blood analysis, a fluoroscopic C-arm for hysterosalpingography, a donor egg program, fertility preservation for cancer patients, on-site acupuncture, adoption agency, and a reproductive psychologist.

Fertility C.A.R.E. also offers free educational and interactive webinars lead by the director, Dr. Mark Trolice, including *Fertility 101*, and *IVF*. In 2004, Trolice founded Fertile Dreams, a non-profit organization focused on the problems and important issues surrounding infertility. Fertile Dreams also provides \$10,000 “Embracing Hope” grants to provide IVF treatments at a clinic of the recipient’s choice.
